Choosing a university

Let's look at what we should pay our attention choosing an educational institution, what sort of information will be important for you:

- Visit the University Open Days. As a rule, they are held several times in April and May, sometimes in June. At this time, the institution is the most informatively open, meetings are held with the institute/university leadership, all audiences are opened. You can walk through the university walls, feel its atmosphere and determine whether it would be desirable to learn in for many years. It is necessary to talk with lecturers and tutors, ask them for a training program. You should also to explore a variety of information stands. There are also, during the Open Day, a lot of information about sports clubs, the cultural life of the Institute, which are also important for the learning process in this or that college or university. Finally, you can ask about where the graduates are held after university graduation, because, as a rule, the most educational institutions keep such statistics for free;
- Check out the University website. At present times, almost all universities and colleges have their own Internet site, which houses a lot of useful information. There are different training programs, and timetables and the lecturers list, where are their names, experience, and qualification. There are presented detailed rules for admission to this educational institution in the university web page: what documents must be submitted, which exams will be passed, what is the process of college admission;
- Search for forums and chat rooms where students communicate about the university, where students express their opinions about it, about studying process there, about popular subjects, about the lecturer's attitude to the students. At these forums, you can find a variety of sometimes contradictory information, but they are interesting because you can draw your own conclusions and ask questions;
- Gather all the information about the education institution, which you can find. This leaflets and handbooks issued by the university, and reference information, which is indicated on a given institution on the Internet and in other directories for entering universities. This sample of the work that students do in the university, and collections of problems they solve, as well as samples of last year's entrance examinations, tests and proposed tasks. This will determine the required level of high school and compared with their level of training;
- Take a talk to someone who is already this university student, who is already studying at this university. The best of all you should ask the students of 3-4 year courses who have already studied in this education institution to give a comprehensive description. As a rule, rarely one of them refuses to talk about their university/college and if you have any time to talk with him over a cup of coffee, then you get a lot of informal communication.
- Visit the educational exhibition. Such exhibitions are often held, especially on the eve of universities admission. Trade shows are convenient in that they present a lot of universities/colleges, it is possible to come to one, then to another booth and talk with representatives of the institution, take a different background information and booklets. You can have whole day just to get a lot of diverse information, which makes it easier to draw final conclusions;
- Read the documents about educational services pavement. Find out the cost of tuition and the payment schedule. The possibility to pay by installments and by the educational services through a bank or a payment terminal will be a nice bonus.
